PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Students are required to take:

Note:International Candidates are required to **complete the Bahasa Malaysia** course to graduate (subject to Senate approval).



DURATION OF STUDY

- 3 semesters / 1.5 year (minimum)
- 8 semesters / 4 years (maximum)



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for the programme should possess:

- A Bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 3.0/4.0 or its equivalent from a recognised university in any relevant field as approved by the Senate.
- International applicants are required to obtain a minimum of TOEFL score 550 (PBT) / 213 (CBT) / 80 (IBT) OR IELTS (Academic) Band 5.5 OR PTE (Academic) score of 42.
