13.	What is PACE in MAYA?	Pathway to Credit Transfer and Exemption (PACE) is an online system in MAYA that allows students to apply for credit transfer and/or course exemption.

14.	What is PACE in MAYA?	PACE stands for Pathway to Credit Transfer and Exemption—the online system in MAYA for applying credit transfer or course exemption. You may view the details on PACE here: https://youtu.be/416eiPC3Lho			
15.	What can I do through PACE?	You may submit applications to transfer credits earned from other institutions or request exemptions for equivalent courses, all through the online platform.			
16.	What should I prepare before submitting my application?	Please ensure you have the following documents ready: Official academic transcript Course syllabus or course outline Any other supporting documents required by the faculty.			
17.	How do I submit my application in PACE?	Log in to MAYA, select PACE, choose either Credit Transfer or Course Exemption, upload the required documents, and submit your application.			
18.	When is the deadline to apply for credit transfer?	Applications must be submitted to the Dean of the Faculty of the respective programme no later than the third week of the Regular Semester. Applications received after the third week will only be considered in the following semester.			
19.	What happens after I submit my application?	Your application will be reviewed by the Faculty's evaluation committee. They will assess the course equivalency and make a decision based on academic requirements.			
20.	How will I be notified of the outcome?	You can check the status and outcome of your application directly in the PACE dashboard in MAYA. Notifications will also be updated there.			
21.	How long is the processing time?	The processing time may vary depending on the complexity of the courses involved. Generally, students can expect an outcome at the end of the semester. Updates will be posted in MAYA once a decision is made.
