- **Israeli Forces Kill Palestinian Man in Military Raid in Al-Bireh (VIDEO)**



Israeli forces killed a Palestinian man on Thursday during a military raid in the occupied West Bank city of al-Bireh, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

Local sources said that

Israeli forces barged their way into the city of Sateh Marhaba, near Al-Bireh, ransacking several houses and sparking confrontations.

The heavily-armed Israeli soldiers opened fire at local youths attempting to block their passage, killing Yazan Afaneh, a 26-year-old resident of the nearby Qalandiya refugee camp, north of Jerusalem.

- **Palestinian Man Killed in Military Raid near Nablus**



Israeli forces killed a Palestinian man on Thursday, in a military raid in the Balata refugee camp, east of Nablus., the official Palestinian news agency Wafa reported.

Local sources said that a sizable army force stormed the refugee camp to conduct arrests, sparking violent confrontations.

Samer Khaled, a 25-year-old resident of the nearby refugee camp of 'Ein Beit el Ma, sustained serious gunshot wounds from the military gunfire in the neck.

- **Israeli Court Refuses to Release Palestinian Prisoner Ahmad Manasra**



Israeli authorities have refused to release Palestinian prisoner Ahmad Manasra, who was arrested in 2015 as a 13-year-old and is suffering from serious mental health conditions.

The Beersheva district court ruled on Thursday that Ahmad Manasra, now 21, would not be released because his case falls under Israel's "counterterrorism law", in response to an appeal filed by Manasra's lawyers.

- **Palestinian detainee, Awawda, suspends hunger strike upon reaching deal for his release**



Palestinian detainee in Israeli jails, Khalil Awawda, suspended tonight his 172-day hunger strike after reaching an agreement with Israel to set a ceiling for his administrative detention and to be released on October 2, according to the Detainees and Ex-Detainees Affairs Commission.

Awawda, whose detention was suspended last week but not entirely ended which prompted him to reject it and continue with his hunger strike, will remain in hospital to recover after suffering serious deterioration in his health, according to the Palestinian Prisoner Society.

- **Jewish Settlers, Led by Israeli Lawmaker Ben-Gvir, Storm Palestinian Village near Jerusalem (VIDEO)**



Hundreds of Jewish settlers stormed on Friday the village of Nabi Samuil, northwest of occupied city of Jerusalem, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

WAFA correspondent said that hundreds of settlers, led by Israeli lawmaker Itamar Ben-Gvir and under military protection, barged their way into the village and the mosque, as the military intensified deployments and set up checkpoints in the village and on the roads leading to it.

- Israeli Soldiers Kill Young Palestinian Man near Hebron (VIDEO)



A young Palestinian man was killed on Friday by Israeli occupation soldiers at the Beit Einoun junction, near Hebron (Al-Khalil), the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

Eyewitnesses told WAFA that Israeli soldiers opened fire on the young man, identified as 19-year-old Fadi Mohammad Ghattas and seriously injured him.

- Palestinian Prisoner Dies in Unclear Circumstances



A 40-year-old Palestinian man who has been held in Israel for two months died on Saturday in an Israeli hospital in yet unclear circumstances as the Palestinian Prisoner Society (PPS) held Israel responsible for his death.

The PPS said in a statement that Mousa Abu Mahameed, from the Bethlehem-area village of Beit Tamar, died this morning at the Asaf Harofeh hospital in Israel.

Mahameed, whose family says had neurological problems, was detained two months ago while he was in occupied Jerusalem for not holding an entry permit.

- **Social media watch group documents more than 360 violations against Palestinian content in August**



Sada Social Center, a social media watch group, documented more than 360 digital violations against Palestinian content in August, which included journalists' and activists' accounts in the largest number of violations so far this year. These violations increased with the escalation of the extensive Israeli attacks, especially the recent

aggression on the Gaza Strip, followed by the Israeli attacks in Nablus on August 9, it said in its monthly report on censorship by social media platforms of Palestinian content.

- **Israel to Approve 3,412 New Settlement Units in Jerusalem**



The Israeli occupation's Planning and Building Committee is considering the approval of two settlement plans in Jerusalem, comprising a total of 3,412 housing units, the PLO's Colonization & Wall Resistance

Commission said on Sunday.

Muayyad Shaaban, the Head of the Commission, said in a press statement that the two plans, named TPS YOSH 420-4-7 and TPS YOSH 420-4-10, will approve the construction of around 3,412 new settlement housing units.

The units will be built on an area estimated at 2,100 dunums on the eastern outskirts of occupied Jerusalem.

- **Visitors to West Bank Must Inform Israel of any ‘Love Interests’ with Palestinians**



Foreigners who visit the occupied West Bank must inform Israel's Defense Ministry if they fall in love with a Palestinian, according to new rules drafted by COGAT, the Israeli Defense Ministry body concerned with

The new rules, which take effect from tomorrow, do not apply to those visiting the illegal Jewish settlements.

- **Israeli Authorities Isolate 400 Palestinian Prisoners**



Israeli occupation authorities have isolated 400 Palestinian prisoners for 11 days, the Palestinian Prisoners' Club (PPC) said in a statement on Sunday.

Prisoners affiliated with the Islamic Jihad movement were being distributed among the prisons of Ramon, Eshel, Nafha, Ofer, Hadarim, and Al-Naqab.

According to the statement, Palestinian prisoners being placed under isolation are being denied daily access to the recreation yards.

Hamouri, a resident of occupied East Jerusalem, was detained at his home in March and slammed with three-month administrative detention without charge or trial, which was renewed again in June for three more months and was supposed to end on September 5.

A Toronto-based group, the Canadian Antisemitism Education Foundation (CAEF), is co-organizing an event for this November. It's called "RISE UP Ottawa!"

According to its GoFundMe page, the event is about promoting



education around human rights and celebrating Jewish pride. If that were in fact the case, this would be a wonderful event. However, there is good reason to believe that it's simply not true and that CAEF is not a genuine social justice group at all.

For starters, CAEF published an open letter—addressed to the Mayor of Toronto, John Tory—where it not only denies the illegal occupation of Palestine but the existence of Palestine itself. How does that align with social justice? Isn't social justice about fighting against Palestinian erasure, including the occupation—a material and observable fact?

The Israeli army decided today not to open a criminal investigation into the killing of al-Jazeera Palestinian-American journalist Shireen Abu Akeh, despite admitting that she was likely

“accidentally” killed by an Israeli soldier.

An investigation conducted by the Israeli military found that there is a high possibility that Abu Akeh, 51, was killed by Israeli fire while she was covering a military raid in the occupied West Bank city of Jenin on May 11.

- **Israeli Occupation Forces Raid Jenin, Kill Palestinian Man**



A Palestinian man was killed early Tuesday morning while several others were injured by Israeli gunfire in the occupied West Bank city of Jenin, the official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported.

The Palestinian Ministry of Health confirmed that Mohammad Musa Sabaaneh, 29, was killed by Israeli soldiers during a large-scale military raid.

Israeli occupation forces broke into the city and surrounded a building of 29 apartments. They forced its residents out before proceeding to demolish an apartment belonging to the family of Raad Hazem, who carried out an attack in Tel Aviv last April before being later shot and killed.
