- **Two Palestinians, Including Child, Killed in Israeli Army Assault on Jenin Refugee Camp (VIDEO)**



Two Palestinians were shot and killed on Friday in an Israeli army assault on the Jenin refugee camp in the northern West Bank, the Palestinian Health Ministry said.

The Ministry identified one of the victims as Farouq Jamil Salameh, 28. Salameh, whose marriage was in two

days, was shot in the abdomen, chest, and head. He died shortly after arriving at a Jenin hospital in critical condition.

The second victim was identified as 14-year-old Mohammad Samer Khlouf, from the town of Burqin, who succumbed to the wounds he sustained from army gunfire during the assault.

On November 3, Israeli forces and settlers launched a number of separate attacks on Palestinians across the West Bank and Jerusalem, leaving five dead in the span of 24 hours. In addition, Israeli forces arrested 17 Palestinians in overnight invade-and-arrest

The five were killed in three separate incidents across the West Bank — Daoud Mahmoud Rayyan and Habas Rayyan in Beit Duqqa; Amer Halabiya in occupied Jerusalem; and Farouq Salameh and Mohammad Khlouf in Jenin refugee camp.

- **The story of the Lions' Den**



The Lions' Den was relatively unknown outside of Nablus until a few months ago but today they have gained hero-like status across Palestine — for leading a revival of armed resistance against Israeli colonialism. This is their story.

The streets of the Old City of Nablus are quieter than usual.

The typically bustling streets, filled with the sights, smells, and sounds of one of the oldest markets in Palestine, are almost unrecognizable. Most shops and businesses are shuttered; those who are open are noticeably somber, a far cry from the usual animated calls of street vendors advertising their wares to crowds of shoppers passing by.

- **Israeli Warplanes Strike Target in Central Gaza**



Israeli warplanes attacked a target in the central Gaza Strip on Friday morning, causing massive destruction and fire in the area, the official Palestinian news agency Wafa reported.

Wafa correspondent said Israeli fighter jets bombed with at least six missiles a target near Maghazi refugee camp in the

central Gaza Strip.

The attack caused massive destruction and fire in the area, as well as minor damages to neighboring homes and facilities.

- **Youth shot and injured, dozens suffocate as Israeli forces quell Beit-Dajan anti-settlement rally**



A Palestinian youth was shot and injured and dozens of others suffocated as Israeli forces suppressed the peaceful anti-settlement rally in Beit Dajan to the east of Nablus

Forces attacked protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters, shooting and injuring a youth. Dozens of others suffocated due to tear gas inhalation.

- **Israeli occupation forces shoot Palestinian paramedic during raid in Jenin**



A Palestinian paramedic was Monday shot by Israeli gunfire during a military raid into the occupied West Bank city of Jenin, local sources said.

The sources told journalists that Israeli soldiers opened fire at a Red Crescent ambulance vehicle, injuring paramedic Murad Khamaysa live bullet shrapnel in the leg.

Khamaysa was taken to the hospital for treatment.

- **Israeli settlers chop down 100 olive trees & IOF demolish ahouse near Hebron**



Israeli settlers Monday chopped down olive trees and uprooted others in an area east of the village of Tarqumiyah, northwest of the occupied West Bank city of Hebron.

Suleiman al-Ja'afra, an activist, said that settlers from the illegal Israeli settlement of Telem and Adura damaged about 100 trees, including olive trees, owned by al-Zabayna family.

He noted that this is the second time in which Israeli settlers uproot and damage trees in less than a month, adding that this comes within a plan to seize the area in favor of settlement expansion.

Palestinian-American supermodel Bella Hadid on Sunday met the family of slain journalist Shireen Abu Akleh in Doha, Qatar, and showed them support.

In the clip posted on Doha News, Abu Akleh's niece, Lina, is seen giving Hadid a badge in memory of her murdered aunt.

Hadid then proceeded to hug Anton, Abu Akleh's brother, saying: "I am at your disposal if you need anything. I'm so sorry for your loss."

- **Israeli Forces Raid Palestinian School, Intimidate Students, Teachers**



Israeli occupation forces on Sunday raided a school serving the villages of As-Sawiya and al-Lubban al-Sharqiya, near Nablus, the official Palestinian news agency Wafa reported.

According to local sources, Israeli forces threatened students and teachers of opening gunfire at them.

Ghassan Daghlis, a local anti-occupation activist, told Wafa that Israeli soldiers raided the school twice in the morning and threatened to open fire at any student who allegedly throws stones at them.

- **Lost at sea**



Ahlan al-Astal can only focus on one thing at the moment: finding her son.

She had her last conversation with him on 10 October. Sakhar, her son, told her that he was heading to Greece from Turkey.

His mother pleaded with him not to risk his life. Sakhar replied that he had a good

plan but did not elaborate.

On 17 October, the Palestinian Authority's embassy in Athens released some grim details.

The bodies of two Palestinians from Gaza had been recovered near the Greek island of Kos, the embassy stated. A third man was still missing.

Sakhar, 25, is the man who has not yet been located.

A trained blacksmith, Sakhar emigrated earlier this year. He was not making enough money in Gaza to help meet his family's needs.

He went first to Egypt and then traveled to Istanbul. He had been in Turkey for barely a month, when he and two friends set out for Greece.

- **Israeli warplanes attack Gaza Strip in fresh act of aggression**



The Israeli military has carried out a round of airstrikes against the Gaza Strip, as the Tel Aviv regime continues with its acts of aggression on the besieged Palestinian coastal enclave.

The military alleged in a statement that it targeted in the early hours of Friday morning a Hamas underground facility, which the resistance movement used for the production of rocket materials in the

central Gaza Strip.

It published a satellite photo of what it said was the site, showing an area near several buildings and agricultural plots on the northwest edge of the al-Maghazi refugee camp. It said it was the third such facility hit since April.

- **Israel assassinates “the lion of the Balata Brigade”**



On Wednesday afternoon, November 9, 17-year-old Mahdi Mohammad Hashash was killed near Balata refugee camp, east of Nablus.

His head covered with a traditional black-and-white Kuffiyeh, his body wrapped in a Palestinian flag with a rifle laying on top of him, Hashash — whose nomme de

guerre was Shimon — was laid to rest by his family and resistance fighters who had come to attend his burial.

During the funeral procession, fighters from the Lions’ Den — the armed resistance group based in the Old City of Nablus — held their rifles as they marched, carrying the body of their slain comrade, “the lion of the Balata Brigade.”

- **Illegal Jewish Settlement Submits Petition to Resume Building in East Jerusalem**



The municipal council of the illegal Jewish settlement of Maale Adumim has submitted a petition to implement a building scheme in East Jerusalem, Israeli media reported.

According to Israel Hayom newspaper, the council filed a petition to the Jerusalem District

Court to resume building in the E1 area, linking occupied East Jerusalem and the West Bank.

The petition is reportedly aimed at putting pressure on Israeli political parties, which are currently conducting consultations to form a new right-wing government.
